#### LETTER TO THE EDITOR:

On January 24, at 1:30am, I had to 911 as my husband was in the midst of a major stroke. We live on South Venice Boulevard.

I am fully aware that the street name is "South Venice" but when the 911 dispatcher typed it in he entered S. Venice Blvd and proceeded to say "I don't have that street. I have E. Venice and W. Venice, but no S. Venice." After back and forth a couple of times I had to direct him through his program by saying, "O.K. Find US 41 and Baffin. Go west on Baffin turn south on Shamrock. Follow Shamrock."

All while my husband was potentially dying. The dispatcher finally said, "Oh my. I have to fully spell out S O U T H for the street to show in the system. Not his fault. He was prompt and professional.

Clearly the system needs to be fixed. Until it is, all of us on South Venice Boulevard should be aware of that awful, frightening glitch in the 911 mapping system.
