

- VINES: Grape, Virginia Creeper and Passion Vine
- FLOWERS: Salvia, Coreopsis, Black-eyed Susan, Aster, Sunflower. Some hummingbird favorites include Firebush, Morning Glory, Trumpet Honeysuckle, Tropical Sage, and Dotted Horsemint.

State of the Market

Welcome to Fall and a little cooler weather—but still sunny here in South Venice Beach!

During the period spanning from September 16 to October 15, South Venice Beach experienced a vibrant real estate market, maintaining its allure as a favorite destination. A total of 26 closings were recorded, indicating a stable market activity, albeit a slight dip from the previous period, which is typical for this time of year.

The highlight of this period was the sale of a stunning property located at 5220 Drew Rd. This luxurious 4-bedroom, 3-bathroom house, boasting 2,265 square feet of living space, was built in 2020. It featured a spacious pool and was situated on a generous 10,000 square foot lot, ultimately closing at
